This Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner/accused under section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking to relax the conditions imposed on the petitioner/accused in CrI.MP.No. 3223 of 2016 vide order dated 26/10/2016 passed by the Metropolitan Sessions Judge-cum-I-Additional District and Sessions Judge, Visakhapatnam, directing to furnish personal bond of Rs. 1.00,000/- [Rs. One Lakh only] each and two sureties each who shall furnish a fixed deposits of Rs. 1.00,000/- [Rs. One Lakh only] each to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial First Class Magistrate, Anakapalli.

2. Heard the counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of the State.

3. I find no grounds to interfere with the order dated 26/10/2016 passed by the Metropolitan Sessions Judge-cum-I-Additional District and Sessions Judge, Visakhapatnam, in CrI.MP.No. 3223 of 2016.

4. The Criminal Petition is accordingly dismissed.

5. As a sequel, miscellaneous petitions if any pending in this Criminal Petition shall stand disposed of.
