

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.K.JAISWAL

CRIMINAL PETITION No.9834 of 2016

ORDER:

The criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.8 of 2008 on the file of the Special Judge for CBI Cases, Hyderabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 120-B, 420 and 471 IPC and Section 13(2) r/w 13(1)(d) of P.C. Act, 1988.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner/A16 and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the State.

Counter affidavit is filed on behalf of the respondent/State.

Specific allegations were made in the complaint against the petitioner. The truth or otherwise of the allegations can only be decided during course of trial. This Court is not supposed to make a roving enquiry into the allegations made in the charge sheet. I see no ground to quash the charge sheet.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the Criminal Petition is disposed of, directing the learned Magistrate to dispose of C.C. expeditiously, preferably within six (06) months from today, however, without insisting for the presence of the petitioner/A16 for each and every adjournment, unless it feels that his physical presence is necessary for any specific purpose.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
