

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.K.JAISWAL

CRIMINAL PETITION No.11665 of 2016

ORDER:

The criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in D.V.C.No.5 of 2015 on the file of the Addl.Judicial First Class Magistrate, Bodhan, Nizamabad District.

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners/respondents 1 to 6 in DVC and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, representing the State.

Specific allegations were made in the complaint against the petitioners. The truth or otherwise of the allegations can only be decided during course of trial. This Court is not supposed to make a roving enquiry into the allegations made in the charge sheet. I see no ground to quash the DVC proceedings.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the Criminal Petition is disposed of, directing the Court below to proceed with the enquiry and dispose of the above case, as expeditiously as possible, however, without insisting for the presence of the petitioners 2 to 6/respondents 2 to 6 in DVC for each and every adjournment, unless it feels that their physical presence is necessary for any specific purpose. It is made clear that the 1st petitioner/1st respondent in DVC shall continue to appear throughout the enquiry.

Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand closed in consequence.
