Heard Mr. S.Ravi, learned Senior counsel for the appellant, learned Advocate General for Respondent Nos. 1,2 and 3 and Mr. K. Vivek Reddy, learned counsel for respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the parties have agreed for disposal of this appeal in terms of the order that we propose to pass. Hence, we dispose of the appeal by the following order:

- “1. The writ appeal is disposed of as not pressed. It is open to the appellant to make an application under Section 22 of the Andhra Pradesh Land Revenue Act, 1948.
2. The statement made by Mr. K. Vivek Reddy, learned counsel for respondent No.4 that respondent No.4 is ready to accept the compensation offered by the appellant for acquisition of the property, without prejudice to their rights and contentions and also their right to file appropriate proceedings for enhancement thereof. The statement made by Mr. S. Ravi, learned Senior counsel for the appellant at this stage, that the appellant

shall file appropriate proceedings for enhancement of compensation within a period of one month from today is recorded and accepted.”

The writ appeal is accordingly disposed of in terms of this order.

Consequently, pending miscellaneous applications shall also stand closed.
