

**HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO**

**WRIT PETITION No.45202 of 2016**

**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed seeking a writ of mandamus declaring the action of respondents 5 to 13 in not obeying the orders of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent and consequent direction of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent in not following the same and not passing orders on the petitions filed by the petitioners before the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent as illegal and arbitrary, and consequently, direct the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to take appropriate action in pursuant to the orders of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in A.O.S.No.1 of 2015 dated 27.06.2015.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

Though several allegations are made in the writ petition, the learned counsel for the petitioners after arguing for sometime confined his arguments to the extent of giving a direction to 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to implement the orders of 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent dated 27.06.2016.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on merits, the Writ Petition is disposed of directing the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent to strictly implement the orders of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent passed in A.O.S.No.1 of 2015 dated 27.06.2015 in accordance with law. No costs.
