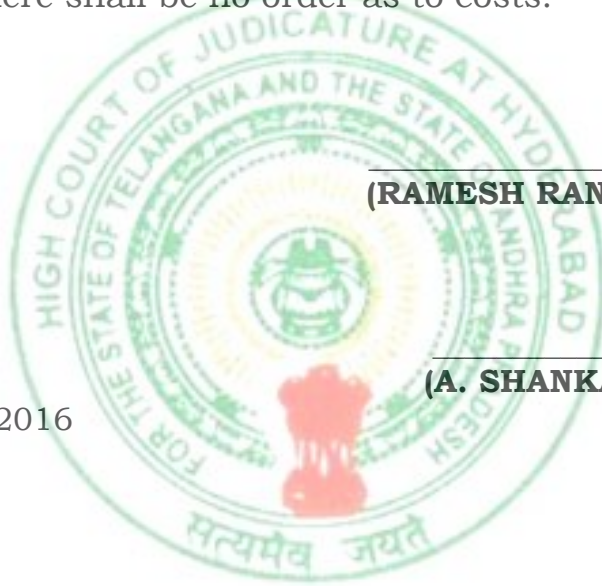
Granting liberty as sought for, the writ petition is dismissed. The miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall also stand dismissed. There shall be no order as to costs.
