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The Court made the following:

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Order : (Per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

Feeling aggrieved by grant of an *ex parte* interim order in OA.No.1462 of 2016 by the Andhra Pradesh Administrative Tribunal, Hyderabad (for short 'the Tribunal'), the applicant in MA.No.701 of 2016 has filed this Writ Petition.

On the petitioner's own showing, he has filed this Writ Petition for his impleadment in the OA. Considering the fact that the petitioner has filed MA.No.701 of 2016 for his impleadment in the OA along with an application for vacating the *ex parte* interim order, we are not inclined to dwell into the merits of the case as sought to be argued by Mr.P.V.Krishnaiah, learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner. However, it will suffice if the Tribunal disposes of MA.No.701 of 2016 along with the vacate stay application filed by the petitioner expeditiously.

Accordingly, the Tribunal shall dispose of the above applications or OA.No.1462 of 2016 itself subject to its discretion as the case may be within one month from the date of receipt of this order.

Subject to the above direction, the Writ

Petition is disposed of.

As a sequel to disposal of the Writ Petition, WPMP.No.21303 of 2016, filed by the petitioner for interim relief, is disposed of as infructuous.
