

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.38448 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.397 of 2016 on the file of Kachiguda Police Station, Hyderabad.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is stated in the affidavit that the above crime was registered for the offence under Sections 340, 362, 365, 383 and 506 IPC against the petitioner alleging that the petitioner and complainant purchased a land and later, they sold them and sustained loss. But the petitioner blamed the complainant and demanded him to pay the money invested by him. The petitioner along with other accused took the complainant in a car, confined him, beat him and obtained his signatures on the promissory note for Rs.14,90,000/- and threatened him. It is the case of the petitioner that the present complaint was lodged with a view to avoid repayment of the amount due to him.
4. The petitioner filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioner. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned daily in between 10 a.m., and 5 p.m., for a period of one month and he is also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Station

House Officer concerned, as surety for his future appearance as and when required for the purpose of investigation.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
