Smt. P. Vijaya Lakshmi, learned counsel for the petitioner, would submit that as the vehicle was released after the writ petition was filed, on collection of the compounding fee from the petitioner, the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the writ petition with liberty to question the order passed imposing the compounding fee on the petitioner.
