JUDGMENT: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

This appeal is filed by A1 in Sessions Case No.66 of 2006, on the file of the II Additional District and Sessions Judge (Fast Tract Court), Sangareddy, against the judgment, dated 17.06.2010, whereby he was convicted for the offence punishable under section 302 r/w.149 IPC and sentenced to suffer rigorous imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of Rs.2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only), in default, to suffer simple imprisonment for six months.

At the hearing, Smt.C.Vasundhara Reddy, representing Sri Palle Sriharinath, learned counsel for the appellant, submitted that during the pendency of the appeal, the appellant died.

In view of this subsequent event, the Criminal Appeal has abated and the same is accordingly dismissed as such.
