

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

Crl.P.M.P.Nos.2614 & 2615 OF 2016

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CRIMINAL PETITION No.2548 OF 2016

ORDER:

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The above Criminal Petition is filed by the petitioner-accused under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking to quash the proceedings against him in Crime No.7 of 2016 on the file of the Tirumala Town Police Station, Tirupathi Urban, registered for the offence punishable under Section 420 IPC.

When this matter has been taken up, the petitioner and the 2nd respondent-de facto complainant, who appeared before this Court, submitted through their Counsel that due to intervention of elders, they entered into compromise and therefore, the proceedings in the above crime may be quashed. The 2nd respondent-de facto complainant filed an affidavit to that effect. Both the parties filed a joint memo also.

In view of the compromise arrived at between the parties, the continuation of the proceedings against the petitioner-accused would be the exercise in futility.

In the above circumstances and in view of the compromise, this Court feels that it is just and proper to quash the proceedings against the petitioner herein. Hence, the above Crl.M.Ps are ordered, and the proceedings against the petitioner-accused in Crime No.7 of 2016 on the file of Tirumala Town Police Station, Tirupathi Urban, are quashed. The petitioner-accused is directed to pay Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) towards costs to the Andhra Pradesh State Legal Services Authority. The Registry is directed to issue a copy of this order to the petitioner-accused after furnishing receipt of payment of costs.

Accordingly, the above Crl.M.Ps are ordered and the Criminal Petition is allowed. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any,

shall stand closed.
