

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.43004 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to quash the proceedings against them in FIR No.220 of 2015 on the file of Kandukur Police Station, Cyberabad.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. On the reference of the private complaint lodged by the unofficial respondents Nos.4 to 6, to the police under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C., the above crime was registered for the offence under Sections 120-A & B, 464, 469, 420, 471 r/w 34 IPC. It is alleged that the petitioners created fake documents in respect of the property of the unofficial respondents, whereas it is the grievance of the petitioners that they have not committed any offence as alleged in the complaint.
4. The petitioners filed this writ petition challenging the investigation in the above crime. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the investigation in the above crime. However, taking into consideration the fact that the investigation is based on the documents, the official respondents are directed to complete the investigation and file a final report, in accordance with law, without arresting the petitioners. The petitioners are directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned as and when required and they are also directed to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) with one surety each for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the Station House Officer concerned, as surety for their future appearance as and when required.

5. With the above direction, the Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
Consequently, miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
