

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

CRIMINAL PETITION No.1877 of 2016

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) to quash the proceedings in crime No.26 of 2013 on the file of the Mahila Police Station, Anantapur, registered for the offences under Sections 498-A IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Heard and perused the material.

On perusal of the entire material available on record, *prima facie* there are allegations against the petitioners/A.1 to A.3, which are to be investigated into by the police. Hence, this Court is not inclined to quash the impugned proceedings at this stage. However, considering the submission of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners are ready and willing to cooperate with the investigating agency, the concerned police are directed to complete the investigation without arresting the petitioners/A.1 to A.3 and file final report, if any, in accordance with law. The police are directed to issue notice to the petitioners/A.1 to A.3 for their appearance for the purpose of investigation and the petitioners are also directed to appear and cooperate with the investigating agency. The petitioners are also directed to submit an Undertaking for their future appearance for the purpose of investigation.

The Criminal Petition is accordingly disposed of. Miscellaneous Petitions filed in this Criminal Petition, if any, shall stand closed.
