

THE HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

CRIMINAL PETITION No.2081 of 2016

ORDER:

The Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C) by the petitioner seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.157 of 2010 on the file of the XI Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad, registered for the offence under Section 382 IPC.

Heard and perused the material available on record.

When the case is taken up for hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned counsel for the *de facto* complainant submit that they have filed CrI.P.M.P.No.2027 of 2016 seeking permission of this Court to compound the offences and consequently, to quash the proceedings. Along with the said application, they have filed the Joint Memo signed by the complainant as well as the petitioner and also the same is signed by the counsel for both the parties. Both the parties are present in the Court and asserted that they have entered into compromise.

Considering the above, the petitioner and the *de facto* complainant are permitted to compound the offences. In view of the amicable settlement of the dispute between the parties, CrI.P.M.P.No.2027 of 2016 is ordered and the compromise is recorded. Consequent thereto, the criminal petition is allowed and the proceedings in C.C.No.157 of 2010 on the file of the XI Additional Chief Metropolitan Magistrate, Secunderabad, are hereby quashed.

The petitioner is directed to pay Rs.3,000/- (Rupees three thousand only) as costs to the Telangana State Legal Services Authority. The Registry is directed to issue order copy only on production of the receipt of payment issued by the Telangana State Legal Services Authority.

The Criminal Petition is accordingly allowed with costs. Consequently, miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending, shall stand closed.
