

HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO

WRIT PETITION No.37113 of 2016

ORDER:

1. This writ petition is filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to direct respondents Nos.3 and 4 not to interfere with the peaceful possession and enjoyment of the petitioner over the subject lands.
2. Heard and perused the material available on record.
3. It is stated in the affidavit that there are civil disputes between the 4th respondent and the petitioner. At the instance of the 4th respondent, the 3rd respondent is calling the petitioner to the police station and directing him to hand over possession of the subject lands to the 4th respondent.
4. Considering facts and circumstances of the case and the grievance of the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on merits, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the following direction:

“Respondent No.3 is directed not to interfere with the affairs of the petitioner more particularly, in any of the civil disputes in respect of the subject property. At the same time, this order will not stand in the way of the above respondent to proceed with the investigation, if any case is registered against the petitioner for cognizable offence.”

There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
