ORDER

This criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in DVC.No.1/2016 on the file of Judicial First Class Magistrate, Narsampet, Warangal District, registered against the petitioner, who are respondents 1 to 10 before the trial court, for the alleged offence punishable under the provisions of the Domestic Violence Act.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

A perusal of the material on record reveals that specific allegations were made against the petitioners. The truth or otherwise of the allegations can only be decided during course of trial. I see no ground to interdict at this stage and quash the proceedings.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the criminal petition is disposed of, directing the trial court to dispose of the case as expeditiously as possible, without insisting the presence of the petitioners 2 to 10, unless required for any specific purpose. The petitioner No.1 – husband, shall appear before the lower court during the course of trial.

Miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed. No costs.
