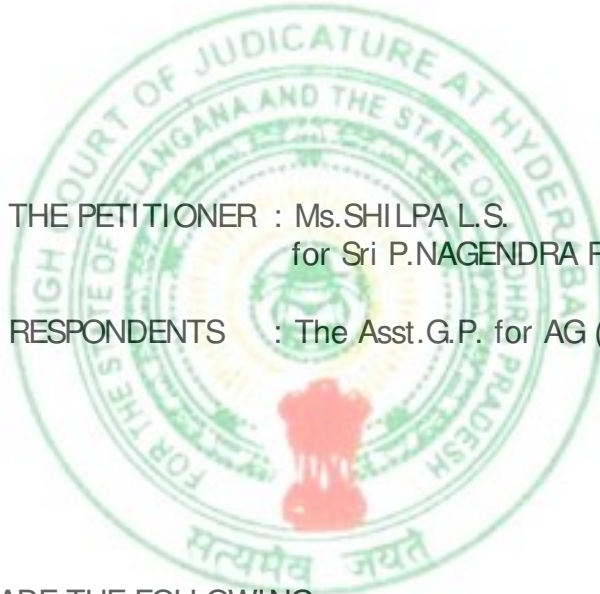

JUDGMENT: (per Hon'ble Sri Justice C.V.Nagarjuna Reddy)

This writ petition is filed for the following substantive relief:

“...to issue a writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of Habeas Corpus, directing the respondents to produce the son of the petitioner, named Bommareddy Raghu Pavan Reddy, S/o.Sudhakara Reddy, aged about 16 years, II year Intermediate student, R/o.Flat No.209, Everest Block, Aditya Enclave, Ameerpet, Hyderabad before the Hon'ble Court forthwith and set him at liberty.”
