The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for the following
substantive relief:

“... to issue a Writ of *Mandamus* declaring the
action of respondent No.1 in conducting

public auction on 15-10-2014 for the license hold rights to collect the coconut halves for a period of one year from 16-10-2014 as per notification dated 01-10-2014 issued by the respondent No.1-temple as illegal, arbitrary, void, against the principles of natural justice and violative of Article 14 of Constitution of India and consequently, to quash the auction notification, dated 01-10-2014.”

At the hearing, Mr. M.Vidyasagar, learned counsel representing Mr. W.B.Srinivas, learned counsel for the petitioner, has submitted that the cause in the Writ Petition does not survive for adjudication.

In view of the said submission, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous.

As a sequel to dismissal of the Writ Petition, interim order, dated 14.10.2014, in WPMP.No.38230 of 2014 is vacated and WPMP.No.38230 of 2014 and WVMP.No.3211 of 2014 are dismissed as infructuous.
