

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE M.S.K.JAISWAL

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CRIMINAL PETITION No.12509 OF 2016

ORDER:

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This criminal petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.1070 of 2016 on the file of XV Metropolitan Magistrate, Ranga Reddy District at Medchal, registered against the petitioners/A-1, A2 and A4 for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 498-A IPC and 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned Public Prosecutor appearing for the State.

A perusal of the material on record reveals that specific allegations were made against the petitioners. The truth or otherwise of the allegations can only be decided during course of trial. I see no ground to interdict at this stage and quash the proceedings.

Considering the nature of allegations against petitioner No.1/Accused No.1, the criminal petition is dismissed as far as petitioner No.1 is concerned. The petitioner No.1 shall appear before the trial Court during course of trial.

In the facts and circumstances of the case and as requested by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the criminal petition is disposed of, directing the trial court to dispose of the case as expeditiously as possible, without insisting the presence of petitioners 2 and 3/accused Nos.2 and 4 unless required for any specific purpose. It is needless to observe that petitioners 2 and 3/A2 and A4 are at liberty to move trial court for appropriate relief under law, including that of petition for discharge.

Miscellaneous petitions pending, if any, shall stand closed.
