

**HONOURABLE SRI JUSTICE RAJA ELANGO**

**WRIT PETITION No.43659 of 2016**

**ORDER:**

This writ petition is filed seeking to declare the action of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in interfering with petitioners' personal life and liberty by pressurizing the petitioners to hand over the hand loan agreement, dated 15.05.2015, to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and also to forego the amount which was lent to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent by the petitioner, as illegal and arbitrary and consequently direct the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent not to interfere with petitioners' personal life and liberty and also not to pressurize the petitioners to hand over the hand loan agreement, dated 15.05.2015, to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and also not to insist the petitioners to forego the amount lent to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent.

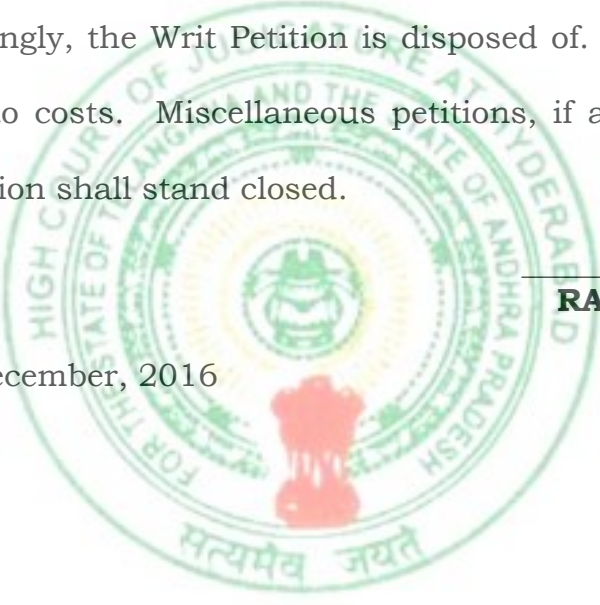
Heard and perused the material available on record.

The case of the petitioners is that the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner, at the request of the 2<sup>nd</sup> petitioner, who is his friend, has lent an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent on 20.02.2015 and the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent paid an amount of Rs.3,00,000/- and executed a loan agreement, dated 15.05.2015, in favour of the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner, for the remaining amount, but the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent has not paid the remaining amount till date and that the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent has approached the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent and that on 10.12.2016, the police constables of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent called the petitioners to the police station and threatened them to forego the hand loan amount and also demanded the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner to hand over the hand loan agreement, dated 15.05.2015, to the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, otherwise, the petitioners will be implicated in false criminal cases. The main

grievance of the petitioners is that the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is pressurizing the petitioners to get settle the issue with the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent and threatening the petitioners that they would be implicated in false criminal cases.

Considering the grievance of the petitioners, the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent is directed not to interfere with the affairs of the petitioners and the 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, more particularly, with the disputes pending between them. However, this order will not stand in the way of the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent to register a case, if any complaint is lodged against the petitioners for cognizable offence.

Accordingly, the Writ Petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this writ petition shall stand closed.
