WRIT PETITION No. 46055 of 2016

ORDER:

- 1) Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Government Pleader for Revenue. With the consent of both the parties, the Writ Petition is being taken up for hearing at the admission stage itself.
- 2) The present Writ Petition came to be filed seeking issuance of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of respondents in not renewing the petitioner's notary certificate, as illegal, arbitrary and violative of Articles 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents to renew the Notary Certificate of the petitioner.
- 3) Heard both sides.
- 4) It is represented by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue involved in the writ petition is squarely covered by an order of this Court, dated 02.12.2016, rendered in W.P.No.9655 of 2016 and Batch.
- 5) In that view of the matter, following the order dated 02.12.2016 passed in W.P.No.9655 of 2016 and Batch, this writ petition is allowed. There shall be no order as to costs.
- 6) Miscellaneous petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed in the light of this final order. No order as to costs.
