WRIT PETITION NOS.18436, 18490 AND 18512 OF 2016

COMMON ORDER: {Per the Hon'ble Sri Justice Ramesh Ranganathan}

Sri S.Ravi, learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners, would submit that consequent on the best judgment assessment orders passed for three different assessment periods by the assessing authority, the petitioners filed an application under Rule 60 of the Andhra Pradesh Value Added Tax Rules ("the Rules" for brevity); and, as their application under Rule 60 of the Rules was rejected, they had filed the present Writ Petitions; subsequently, they have questioned the assessment orders themselves in W.P.Nos.22333, 22172 and 22324 of 2016 and, therefore, they be granted permission to withdraw these three Writ Petitions with liberty to pursue W.P.Nos.22333, 22172 and 22324 of 2016.

Granting liberty as sought for, all these three Writ Petitions are dismissed as withdrawn. There shall be no order as to costs. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending shall stand dismissed.
