This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties are real brothers. They had entered into a partnership agreement on the terms and conditions contained in the partnership deed. Clause 13 thereof contains an arbitration agreement. The petitioner has, however, not even called upon the respondent to appoint an arbitrator as yet.

3. The petition is, therefore, disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh petition after serving the notice upon the respondent invoking the arbitration agreement and calling upon him to agree to the appointment of an arbitrator.
