This is a petition under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for the appointment of an arbitrator.

2. The parties had entered into a collaboration agreement dated 02.04.2007. Disputes and differences have arisen between the parties. The petitioner had in fact filed arbitration case No.153 of 2015 for the appointment of an arbitrator, which was disposed of my order dated 20.11.2015. The order recorded that the respondent had agreed to furnish certain documents that the petitioner demanded. The order further permitted the petitioner to withdraw the petition with liberty to file a fresh petition

with the same relief and the respondent was directed to furnish the

documents within one month.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner states that the respondent has still not furnished the documents. It is in these circumstances that this petition has been filed.

In these circumstances, the petition is disposed of by appointing Mr. Mukul Mudgal, Chief Justice (Retd.) of this Court, as the sole arbitrator.
