AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Learned senior counsel for the respondent states that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with in the light of the decision of the University in its letter dated 22.07.2015 (Annexure R-2).

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the order which has been passed by the respondent is not in consonance with the order passed by this Court in CWP No.25548 of 2014, titled as 'Jagjit Singh & others Vs. Punjabi University Patiala', dated 15.12.2014 (Annexure P-1), as they have simply kept in abeyance the decision with regard to the implementation of the 85th Amendment of the Constitution. He contends that the seniority should in any case be fixed, may be promotion, cannot be given effect to.

This contention of the counsel for the petitioner is subject to

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interpretation, which this Court in the contempt petition would not like to delve into. In case the petitioners so feel, they may avail of their remedy in accordance with law against the order dated 22.07.2015 (Anenxure R-2) passed by the respondent.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
