The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner wife alleging non-compliance of order dated 28.3.2014 passed by the Guardian Judge directing handing over interim custody of the child to her.

It is not in dispute that orders passed subsequently regarding giving interim custody of the child are being complied with by the respondent. Both the parties are present in person in Court. The respondent stated that in future he will continue to comply with the order passed by the Guardian Court on 9.7.2014.

As there was default by the respondent in not giving interim custody to the petitioner on one date of hearing, which order was also challenged, though belated, I do not find any reason to interfere in the present contempt petition, especially considering the statement made by the respondent that he will continue to comply with the order regarding interim custody of the child.
