Rajesh Bindal, J.

On 16.11.2015, this Court passed the following order:-

“There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. Last opportunity is granted to him to make his submissions. He is also directed to remain present in Court on the date fixed. A copy of this order be served upon him.

Adjourned to 26.4.2016.”

The petitioners are not present in person in Court.

The violation of the order dated 9.4.2014 directing status quo regarding possession passed in Civil Revision No. 757 of 2014 has been alleged in the present petition.

The stand of the respondents is that Gram Panchayat had taken the possession of the land in question from the petitioners on 23.7.2013 and thereafter the same had been leased out in open auction on 28.11.2013.

Considering the aforesaid facts, no case for contempt is made out. The same is accordingly dismissed.
