Reply on behalf of the respondents, filed today in the Court, is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondents submits that all the service benefits under the ACP scheme has been released to the petitioner vide order dated 15.06.2016.

However, counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have not paid the amount of commutation pension and gratuity. Since the direction issued by this Court was only for grant of 9 years' service benefit under the ACP scheme, therefore, the present petition is disposed of.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a comprehensive representation in respect of the other dues and in case such a representation is made, the Competent Authority shall decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of two months thereafter.
