The present contempt petition has been filed by an employee working in the Bhiwani Sessions Division alleging non-compliance of the directions issued by this Court regarding disposal of the pending enquiries within a period of six months and further the judgments of Hon'ble the Supreme Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, I do not find any reason to entertain the present petition. Firstly, no contempt is maintainable for alleged violation of any administrative instructions and secondly every endeavour is made to conclude the departmental enquiry as expeditiously as possible, however, still if not concluded within the reasonable time, as observed by the Courts in various judgments, the same cannot be subject matter of contempt. The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
