The grievance of the petitioner is that interim order dated 15.1.2015 restraining the respondents from changing the nature of the property has been violated, as in the marriage palace, wheat was stored. The stand of the respondents is that temporarily, on the open space, certain wheat bags have been stored. The nature of the property as such was not changed.

Considering the aforesaid fact, I do not find any reason to continue with the present contempt petition and the same stands disposed of.
