Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition in order to file an application in CWP No.7926 of 2001, which was disposed of as infructuous because during the pendency of the writ petition, the petitioner had attained the age of superannuation and as such the *show cause notice* against which the writ petition was filed had died its own death.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that after disposal of the writ petition, the respondents have again issued the same *show cause notice*, therefore, the remedy lies with the petitioner to file an application in the said writ petition for revival of the same.
