AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

On the last date of hearing, counsel for respondents had informed the Court that Civil Revision No.2000 of 2014 (Nikhil Bhagat Vs. Usha Rani Bhagat and others), wherein interim order was passed, contempt of which is alleged, has merged with the final order, which has been passed by this Court on 03.05.2016, dismissing the revision petition.

Counsel for the petitioner as also Ms. Sunanda Bhagat, mother of minor petitioner, who is present in person in Court, could not dispute the said fact. However, it has been insisted upon by Ms.Sunanda Bhagat that interim order, which was passed by this Court, had been violated by the respondents.

The said plea of Ms. Sunanda Bhagat cannot be accepted in

the light of the fact that the interim order, which was passed by this Court, has merged with the final order of this Court.

It has been further asserted by Ms. Sunanda Bhagat that FIR has been lodged by her on 14.06.2014 (Annexure P-7 with the application), which is pending and that action be taken against the respondents.

This plea of Ms. Sunanda Bhagat also cannot be accepted as the FIR already stands registered and she may pursue her remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.

Since the main contempt petition stands disposed of, no orders are required to be passed on C.M. Nos.18287-88 CII of 2014.
