AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner has been considered and he has been found eligible and in accordance thereto, appointment letter to the post of Vocational Master (Computer Science) has been issued to him on 15.01.2016. Counsel contends that as per the settled law, petitioner is entitled to be considered for appointment from the date his juniors/batchmates were issued the appointment letter, although he may not be entitled to the monetary benefits. He states that a representation claiming the said benefits will be submitted by the petitioner to Director, Secondary Education, Punjab, within a period of four weeks, which may be directed to be considered and decided by passing a speaking order within some specified time.

In case the petitioner submits such a representation, the same shall be considered and decided by the Director, Secondary Education, Punjab, within a period of eight weeks by passing a speaking order and convey the decision to the petitioner forthwith.

With these observations, the present contempt petition is disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
