MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order dated 8.7.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-11 with the writ petition) in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
