AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Learned proxy counsel appearing for the petitioners has sought an adjournment on the ground that the counsel is in some personal difficulty, however, this Court has gone through the order passed by this Court dated 05.05.2015, contempt of which is alleged and the reply which has been filed by the respondent, according to which, petitioners have been released the pensionary benefits as per their entitlement.

This Court is, thus, of the opinion that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner(s), in case, they still have any claim qua their pensionary benefits which would fall from the order dated 05.05.2015 passed by this Court, they may file representation to the District Education Officer, Ambala, within a period of six weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same

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shall be considered and decided by the District Education Officer, Ambala, with a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks thereafter. In case some claim is accepted, the same shall be released to the petitioner(s) within a period of four weeks subsequent thereto.

Disposed of with above observations.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged, subject to above.
