In compliance with the order dated 08.11.2016 passed by this
Court, a specific affidavit, as called for, has been filed by the respondent
attaching therewith the payment slips/deposit of cheques in the account of
the petitioner.

In the light of the above, it is apparent that the respondent has

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deposited the amount of maintenance and credited in the account of the petitioner upto October, 2016. Counsel for the respondent further states that that the payment with regard to the maintenance amount of November, 2016, has been deposited. An undertaking has also been given in the affidavit that he would deposit the amount of ₹ 15,000/- per month in the account of the petitioner without any delay.

In the light of the undertaking given by the respondent in the affidavit filed by him, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.
