The order dated 21.1.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-4 with the writ petition) within a period of 4 weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done. A speaking order passed and payments have also been made to the petitioner.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner avail himself of any remedy available to him under the law in the event of any shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
