The order dated 11.3.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation moved by the petitioners, in accordance with law, within a period of 1 month from the date of submission of the representation.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
