AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

In the light of the order dated 04.08.2016, the calculation sheets were, admittedly, handed over to the petitioner by the respondents detailing therein the revision of her pension w.e.f. 1.9.1994 till date but in pursuance thereto, no representation has been submitted by the petitioner to the District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Gurdaspur.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that without service-book, the petitioner is not in a position to make a representation/claim.

If that be so, let the petitioner avail of her remedy in accordance with law including filing of an execution application as this Court, in a contempt petition, will not be in a position to go into the details with regard to the calculations which have been made by the respondents while granting her the relief.

With these observations, the present contempt petition stands disposed of.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
