AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Shri Gulzar Singh, Superintendent, O/o Irrigation Department, Punjab, states that an amount of ₹ 57,875/- stands credited to the account of the petitioner and accordingly, states that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with.

In view of the submission made by the counsel for the respondent, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. However, direction is issued to the respondent to supply the calculation sheet with regard to the claims and the arrears paid to the petitioner within a period of two weeks. If the petitioner is of the view that certain other benefits were also required to be given to him in pursuance to the order passed by this Court and after going through the calculation sheet, he may

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make a representation to the respondent within a period of three weeks. On such submission of the representation, decision thereon shall be taken by the respondent within a period of eight weeks. If any claim of the petitioner is found to be genuine and justified, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged, subject to above.
