Reply to the contempt petition has been filed in Court.

Counsel for the respondent has referred to the order dated 22.08.2016 passed by the Special Secretary, Government of Punjab, Department of Technical Education and Industrial Training, Chandigarh, wherein the claim of the petitioner has been duly considered and a detailed speaking order passed stating therein that the person, who the petitioner alleges to be his junior had been promoted, has been found to be not eligible for consideration, rather a third person, who was senior to both of them, has now been promoted to the post of Principal (Junior Scale, Group A), Government Industrial Training Institute, Kapurthala.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to avail of the remedy, if so advised, in accordance with law.
