Counsel for the respondents states that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous as the order dated 24.12.2014, passed by this Court in Civil Writ Petition No.17115 of 2009 (*Sadhu Ram vs. The Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala and others*) has been duly complied with.

Counsel for the petitioner states that some amounts have been received by the petitioner, as has been detailed in the reply. He, however, seeks liberty to file a representation to the respondents in case there is some other amount due, which representation will be filed by him within a period of two weeks from today.

In case, such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of six weeks. Decision so taken, be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith. In case the claim

is accepted the consequential benefits be also released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

The contempt petition stands disposed of accordingly.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
