Counsel for the petitioner submits that service of the petitioner has been regularized but the consequential benefits have not been paid. He prays that he may be granted liberty to make appropriate representation to the respondents for claiming consequential benefits, which may be directed to be decided by the respondents, in accordance with law, within a specified time.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to make an appropriate representation for claiming consequential benefits after regularization of his service from the respondents and in case any such representation is made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the respondents, in accordance with law, within a period of 4 weeks thereafter.
