On 15.09.2015, direction was issued to the State to take immediate steps to fill up the remaining vacant posts of the TGT English, 178 TGT Punjabi, 43 TGT Urdu and 436 DPE subjects.

Since the respondent did not abide by the order passed by this Court as alleged, the present petition has been filed in which after notice, respondent has filed an affidavit of Keshni Anand Arora, Additional Chief Secretary, School Education, Haryana, who has alleged that 1035 (939+96) posts of TGT English, 31 posts of TGT Urdu, 680 posts of DPE and 189 posts of TGT Punjabi are in the process of being filled.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the interviews are already going on to fill up the posts of TGT Science, DPE, TGT Urdu, TGT Home Science and TGT English. It is further submitted that in so far as TGT Punjabi is concerned, requisition was sent by the department to the Haryana Staff Selection Commission(HSSC)

on 27.01.2016 and soon the process for filling up those posts shall also be started.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that though the order was passed on 27.01.2016 but the respondents have not yet been able to fill up the posts of TGT Punjabi.

Since the process of filling up the posts of TGT English, TGT Urdu and DPE is already on and requisition has already been sent for TGT Punjabi, the present petition is hereby, thus, disposed of as having become infructuous with a direction to the respondent as well to the HSSC to advertise the posts of TGT Punjabi immediately and start the process of filling up those posts in accordance with law. It is needless to mention that the respondent shall take the necessary action within one month from today.

In case, the order passed by this court is not followed in its letter and spirit, petitioners may have liberty to file an application for revival of this petition.

Disposed of as infructuous.
