This is an application for withdrawal of the contempt
petition on the basis of compromise.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the
main petition is taken up for today.

COCP No.126 of 2010

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that
Civil Revision No.3994 of 1996 has already been withdrawn on
account of compromise which was effected in the larger interest
of the parties. Similarly, Civil Writ Petition No.18935 of 2009 has
already been dismissed as withdrawn vide order dated
24.09.2016.

A suit for declaration was filed challenging the orders passed by the Revenue Authorities in partition proceedings. An objection was taken with regard to jurisdiction of the Civil Court. The Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur vide order dated 05.08.1996 held that the Civil Court had the jurisdiction to try the suit. Against the aforesaid order, Civil Revision No.3994 of 1996 was filed in the High Court. COCP No.126 of 2010 was also filed in respect of dis-obedience of order passed by Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), Sangrur vide which defendants-respondents were restrained from obtaining final order. Since, the entire controversy has been settled by means of compromise, Civil Revision No.3994 of 1996 and Civil Writ Petition No.18935 of 2009 have since been dismissed as withdrawn, therefore, it shall be in fitness of things to allow the petitioners to withdraw COCP No.126 of 2010 in the interest of justice.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
