In compliance with the order passed by this Court in CWP No.12780 of 2014, a speaking order has been passed by the Director, Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab, dated 26.09.2016 (Annexure R-1), whereby, claim of the petitioner for the grant of promotion to the Master cadre with effect from the date juniors to him have been promoted, has been accepted.
