Some payments have already been released to him consequent to the acceptance of his claim. There is thus sufficient compliance of the orders of the writ Court, rendering the instant petition infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in case of any shortfalls in the payments.

Respondents would also be duty bound to supply the particulars of the payments made to the petitioner so as to enable him to verify the same.
