Petitioner has preferred this contempt petition alleging that respondent No.4 made a statement before the court which he has not complied with. Thus, this court needs to take cognizance of the issue it being contempt of court.

A perusal of the order passed by Hon'ble Division Bench, however, shows that it was directed that in case respondent No.4 fails to abide by the order, the petition (CWP-2342 of 2015) would stand revived automatically without further orders of the court.

Under the circumstances, this court finds no ground to interfere on the contempt side at this stage.
