Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from Mr. Jatin Sharma, Junior Engineer, Department of Water Supply & Sanitation, Punjab, Amritsar states that the claim of the petitioners has been duly considered and the GPF Number has been allotted to all the petitioners except petitioner No. 22-Jaswinder Singh s/o Sh. Nasib Singh and Swaran Singh-petitioner No.33 as they have expired. However, their claims for the grant of family pension has been duly considered and approved and have been sent to the Accountant General, Punjab on 9.9.2016 and 11.8.2016 respectively.

He further states that the family pension is likely to be disbursed qua these two petitioners namely Jaswinder Singh and Swaran Singh within a period of six weeks.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the

respondents on instructions from Jatin Sharma, Junior Engineer, Department of Water Supply & Sanitation, Punjab, Amritsar, the present Contempt Petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to revive, in case the statement is found to be incorrect or not complied with.

Rule issued to the respondents stand discharged.
