Short affidavit of Additional Chief Secretary (Development), Punjab, Chandigarh has been filed in Court, according to which, after finalization of the Rules and following the procedures under the same, some of the petitioners have been promoted vide order dated 10.11.2015 (Annexures R-2 and R-3).

Counsel for the petitioners states that because of the inaction/delay on the part of the respondents, the other petitioners have suffered because of late notification of the Rules as also the non-constitution of the Departmental Promotion Committee meeting. The result thereof is that the petitioners have not been considered for promotion and grant of the benefit thereof.

In view of the order, which has been passed on 21.02.2015,

the order stands complied with rendering the present contempt petition as infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to avail of their remedy, if they have any grievance, as has been pointed out above, in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
